YOUNG TANGERINE STARS SHINE

After a successful St Albans Hockey Club half-term holiday camp which saw several current international players coaching nearly 70 local young players at Oaklands, youth stayed centre stage on Saturday as 13 year old Dan Burns and 14 year old Sam Vance put in outstanding performances for St Albans HC men's 8th XI, contributing to a 4-1 win over Berkhamsted which saw the club's newest team go second in East Div 9SW. Earlier in the day, a teenager-packed men's 3rd XI, with Boy's Club Captain Callum Emmerson to the fore, recorded an emphatic 4-0 victory over Richmond. On the road, the men's 1st XI played out a goalless draw at Chelmsford in an even game which ended with unconverted chances at both ends. But the highlights of the weekend for the Tangerine Army were two 2-0 away wins, achieved by the St Albans HC Ladies 3rd XI at Potters Bar to go second in East Div 2C, and by the Ladies 5th XI at Stevenage (two Nikki Davies goals) to go second in Five Counties Div 3. This Saturday, the unbeaten Ladies 1st XI head to Horsham, while the men's 1st team headline another full programme of hockey at Oaklands in a 3pm pushback against City of Peterborough.
